2021 Toys for Tots Campaign Ending Mid-December

Our Detachment's 2021 Toys for Tots Campaign will conclude with toy shopping and selections by about 15 community organizations December 14-16. Distributions of toys to approved families will be completed before Christmas.

This year's campaign included toy collection boxes at approximately 190 businesses, restaurants and stores throughout Oconee County, the Pickens County towns of Central, Liberty, Six Mile and Clemson and the Anderson County town of Pendleton.

A centrally located Toy Store at 205 Stork Way (corner of Stork Way and Radio Station Road) in Seneca serves as the hub of the campaign. Detachment member, Len Rock, and his wife Carol, manage the immense task of sorting and organizing the toys, and Detachment Associate member Jim Day coordinates the books and Kindles, based on age and gender appropriateness, and prepare them for the community organizations that subsequently deliver the gifts to the families.

We all owe the following volunteers a huge thanks for doing a wonderful job of collecting toys from the locations and delivering them to our Toy Store. From all reports we will have collected more toys and books than last year, and we will serve more families and children than last year, too. A final report will be issued in January.
