A Vietnam veteran helicopter pilot, he joined the Detachment in 2013 and attended functions as he was able.

Bob Walker, Bill Thompson and Jim Day attended a Veterans Last Patrol celebration at his hospice residence on August 31, 2023. VLP is a non-profit organization that connects veteran volunteers to veterans in hospice care so their last patrol isn't alone. Last year's Marine of the Year presented this year's award to Past Commandant & TFT Coordinator Bob Walker. He missed the ceremony earlier this year because of illness.








SC Associate of the Year
