2021 Toys for Tots Campaign Ending in a Month

Our Detachment's 2021 Toys for Tots Campaign will conclude with toy distributions to approved families by about 15 community organizations in mid-December. December 5 is the last day for toys to be dropped off, and all toys and boxes will need to be delivered to the Toy Store by December 6.

This year's campaign includes toy collection boxes at approximately 190 businesses, restaurants and stores throughout Oconee County, the Pickens County towns of Central, Liberty and Clemson and the Anderson County town of Pendleton.

Bob Walker, Detachment #1131 Commandant, is the overall coordinator for the 2021 campaign. He is assisted by some 20 volunteers who are responsible for distributing the collection boxes, signs, and brochures and for picking up toys from the 190 locations from early October until December 5 on a regular basis. They are supported by members of the Marine Corps League Auxiliary. Any volunteer needing bags, signs, stickers, or other supplies can find them at the designated Toy Store.

The annual Toys for Tots Golf Tournament held on November 8 at Cross Creek Golf Club in Seneca was a terrific success. This year's tournament featured 100 golfers providing hundreds of toys and bicycles and significant cash contributions to the campaign. The tournament, which was our 8th annual, was again coordinated by Eddie Brown and T.J. Grove who performed their magic. Residents at Cross Creek also contributed dozens of toys. A final tally of the toys, bikes and cash will be reported later in the year.

A centrally located Toy Store at 205 Stork Way (corner of Stork Way and Radio Station Road) in Seneca serves as the hub of the campaign and all toys are taken to the store once they are collected by the volunteers. Another Detachment member, Len Rock, and his wife Carol, manage the immense task of sorting and organizing the toys, and Detachment Associate member Jim Day coordinates the books and Kindles, based on age and gender appropriateness, and prepare them for the community organizations that subsequently deliver the gifts to the families.

The Detachment's Toys for Tots website is https://salem-sc.toysfortots.org. The website provides the public with information about the program, how it works, how to donate toys or cash, where the collections boxes are, and how families may apply to be considered.

We encourage all MCL #1131 members to talk about the program to their neighbors and to any churches, non-profit organization with whom they are affiliated, and to any businesses you believe would serve as a suitable location for a collection box. Any suggestions for additional locations may be given to me by calling 864-710-6739 or Bob Walker at 864-882-3532.

Please support this program this year as we really need to make sure that deserving children can enjoy Christmas during a particularly challenging time for our country. If you are willing to volunteer and help us, call me. Donate a toy, make a contribution or volunteer your time to help ensure the Toys for Tots campaign is a success this year. The program has been a signature activity for the Marine Corps, the Marine Corps Reserve, and now the Marine Corps Toys for Tots Foundation since 1947. Detachment #1131 has been managing and implementing this campaign in Oconee County since 2004.
