#### 2021 Toys for Tots Campaign Underway

Our Detachment's 2021 Toys for Tots Campaign launched on October 6 and will conclude with toy distributions to about 15 community organizations in mid-December. Those organizations will in turn provide the toys and books to the families who applied for and are approved to receive gifts for their children. We are expecting the requests and applications to be a bit higher this year due to the long-term impact of the COVID-19 pandemic, and we are hopeful our efforts will result in more donations and toys to meet the needs.

## 2020 Activity and 2021 Plans

In 2020 more than 7,000 toys, stocking stuffers, bicycles, kindles, and books were either collected or purchased with cash donations. 698 children in our area of responsibility of 692 square miles each received at least five toys, a stocking stuffer, and a book. The program serves children in the target ages from birth to 14.

The campaign includes toy collection boxes at approximately 190 businesses, restaurants and stores throughout Oconee County, the Pickens County towns of Central, Liberty and Clemson and the Anderson County town of Pendleton.

Bob Walker, Detachment #1131 Commandant, is the overall coordinator for the 2021 campaign. He is assisted by some 20 volunteers who are responsible for distributing the collection boxes, signs, and brochures and for picking up toys from the 190 locations from early October until early December on a regular basis. They are supported by members of the Marine Corps League Auxiliary. It is my privilege to serve as the coordinator of the toy collection and pickup process again this year.

The annual Toys for Tots Golf Tournament will be on November 8 at Cross

Creek Plantation in Seneca. Kickoff is 9:00 am with breakfast and an 11:00 am shotgun start for the two person teams. Last year's tournament featured 80 golfers providing 230 toys, 19 bicycles and a significant cash contribution to the campaign. The tournament, which will be our 8th year, will again be coordinated by Eddy Brown and T.J. Grove. Entry forms and rules are available from Eddy Brown at bopbrown@bellsouth.net.

A centrally located Toy Store at 205 Stork Way (corner of Stork Way and Radio Station Road) in Seneca will serve as the hub of the campaign and all toys will be taken to the store once they are collected by the volunteers. Another Detachment member, Len Rock, and his wife Carol, manage the immense task of sorting and organizing the toys, and Jim Day coordinates the books and Kindles, based on age and gender appropriateness, and prepare them for the community organizations that subsequently deliver the gifts to the families.
