

The highlight of the past month was the National Pow/MIA Day held at the Oconee County Military Museum on September 16, 2022. The museum honored TSgt Frank W. Watkins, brother of Lewis G. Watkins, our Detachment namesake. TSgt Watkins' B-24 was shot down over Germany on February 22, 1944 and he spent the remainder of the war in a German Prisoner of War camp (Stalag Luft IV) in what is now Poland. Detachment #1131 Associate member Pam Dowd and fellow Oconee County Museum docent Sherrie Ross have been instrumental in gathering letters, medals and other artifacts from the Watkins' surviving sisters Betty Watkins Towe and Nancy Watkins Long as well as niece Hazel Moore.

The first annual POW Recognition Day ceremony was attended by ten Walhalla High School drama students, their teacher Stephanie Necessary, and Walhalla HS principal Jennifer Crawford. Also in attendance were SC State Senator Thomas Alexander, Salem Mayor Lynn Towe, Oconee County School District Superintendent Dr. Thomas Thorsland and Jerry Dyar from the Oconee County Veterans Council. After a brief introduction by Sherrie Ross, students read selected letters home from TSgt Watkins. The event highlighted important local history for students that frequently get little exposure to World War II historical events in the classroom.
