The big events for me this month were approval of this fiscal year's budget, and the SC Department Quarterly Meeting in Columbia. Budget approval was delayed because of several issues. We will do better next year and have the budget approved by May 2024. The major Department Bylaws changes to add Districts and at-large Trustee members were implemented. We discussed in detail what went on at the quarterly meetng at our September monthly business meeting, but I will cover a few major highlights here.

The new Vice Commandants were appointed for each of the four Department Districts. We are in District 1. Our District Vice Commandant, Hadji Harper, was not present at the meeting for me to meet or speak with. The others are Gary Jackson for District 2, Tracey Talley for District 3, and Jimmy Fogle for District 4.

Bylaws added three new Department Trustees as a substitute for all of the Detachment Commandants, primarily as a potential disciplinary work around. Ultimately one of the three will be replaced every year. The 1st year Trustee (Dan Hoffman), will serve 3 years before being replaced. In the interim, the 2nd year Trustee, myself, will serve 2 years before being replaced, and a 3rd year tTrustee, Jim Breen, will serve 1 year before being replaced. From that point forward, every election is for a 3-year term of service.

There was also discussion about the 2024 Department convention. It will be
